
Make a name for yourself



Use your name to make a piece of art.
OPTIONIS:

· Draw your name in block letters, Then doodle or color around it.



Draw your name like you normally would, then draw bubbles around it.



MORE OPTIONS

· Use a gradation.

(gradual change in hue or value.)

hue = color > i.e., changing from Yellow to Red.



Value = shades of light or dark .i.e.,

White to black; pale pink to deep violet.

* In fashion and hair styling, this effect is sometimes referred to as OMBRE. (AHM-bray)




